VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ, order or direction for quashing of Transfer Certificate dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure P-18) issued by respondent No. 2, whereby the admission of the petitioner in Class 11th has been cancelled and other prayers have also been made.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after challenging the relevant Bye Laws of CBSE.
3. In view of the above, present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
4. It is made clear that in case, fresh petition is filed by the petitioner, the same would be considered independently and in accordance with law.
