SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing impugned award dated 28.09.1995, appellate order dated 05.08.1996 and revisional order dated 28.07.1998, Annexures P-4 to P-6, respectively passed by respondents-official authorities.

2. Shorn of details, suffice is to notice that the order passed by the revisional authority is bereft of any reason. Impugned order, Annexure

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P-6, is reproduced hereunder:-

A perusal of the said order shows that the revisional authority has neither noticed the facts nor the submissions raised by counsel for the petitioner nor it has given any reason in support of the order. Order is cryptic and cannot be sustained. Matter deserves to be remitted back to the revisional authority for re-adjudication.
4. Accordingly, writ petition is disposed of. Impugned revisional order, Annexure P-6, is set aside. Matter is remitted to the revisional authority for decision afresh after hearing the parties.
5. Parties are directed to appear before the revisional authority on 10.12.2024 at 10:00 am. It is expected that after considering the arguments addressed by the parties, revisional authority would pass a speaking order giving reasons for its finding.
