1. Prayer in the instant writ petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No. 1 to decide the execution petition No. 35/2021 in a time bound manner as the same has remained pending for more than two years.

2. Reply on behalf of respondent No. 5 has already been filed.

3. Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 to 4 prays for some more time to file reply. However, taking into consideration that the prayer made by the petitioner is only for issuance of direction to the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Faridabad to expeditiously decide the pending execution petition, I do not find that filing of any reply would serve any purpose, rather the same would only further delay in determination of the execution proceedings.

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4. Besides, in view of the order which this Court proposes to pass, reply of the said respondents even otherwise would not be necessary.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the instant case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Faridabad to decide the pending execution petition No. 35/2021 within a period of three months from the date next fixed in accordance with law.
