The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of FIR No. 0002 dated 02.01.2024, under Section 67 of Information Technology Act, 2008; and Sections 294, 384, 385, 389, 500 & 503 of IPC, registered at Police Station Dadri City, District Charkhi Dadri, which is stated to be a counter-blast of FIR No. 0252 dated 12.10.2020, under Sections 323, 34, 341 & 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Dadri City, District Charkhi Dadri.

[2] At the outset, faced with the situation that the investigation in FIR No. 0002 dated 02.01.2024 (supra) is pending with the Investigating Agency, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his client would be satisfied in case his complaint / representation dated 05.02.2024 (P-9) made before the Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri, is considered by the Investigating Agency, while investigating the matter.

[3] The above prayer seems to be justified.

[4] Notice of motion *qua* official respondent Nos. 1 to 3 only at this stage.

[5] Mr. Chetan Sharma, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3-State and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

[6] In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this petition is **disposed off** with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider the aforesaid representation / complaint dated 05.02.2024 (P-9) during investigation in fair and impartial manner.
