AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. This common order shall dispose of above-mentioned two petitions as they involve the same issue.
2. The present Civil Writ Petitions have been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the selection of respondent Nos.5 to 22 to the post of Homeopathic Medical Officer.
3. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners were not appointed, though, they were qualified and meritorious, however, few of the

private respondents did not possess the educational qualifications as on the date of the appointment. However, it is fairly submitted that they have since retired on attaining the age of superannuation, thus due to the afflux of time, the claim made in the petition may not be grantable. However, a liberty is sought for initiating proceedings to seek compensation.

4. Learned State counsel submits that the petition be disposed of as having rendered infructuous.

5. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with liberty as prayed for, in accordance with law.
