1. By this common order, writ petitions numbers CWP Nos.9747-2019, CWP-9752-2019, CWP-9756-2019, CWP-9758-2019, CWP-9759-2019, CWP-9761-2019 and CWP-9762-2019 are being disposed of as identical issue/controversy is involved in the aforesaid writ petitions.
2. CWP-9747-2019 titled as *Virender Singh and others Vs. Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana and others* is taken up first for consideration, since issue involved in all the petitions is identical.

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3. The impugned order in the present case is Annexure P-4 which has been passed by the Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies, Ambala. The learned counsel for the petitioner(s), learned State counsel and learned counsel for respondent-Society are *ad idem* that the aforesaid impugned order (Annexure P-4) passed by the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ambala and the similar orders which have been passed by the Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies in other connected cases, are absolutely unreasoned order because it does not reflect any reason as to why the permission earlier granted was withdrawn. All the learned counsels for the parties, submitted that Assistant Registrar or any other competent authority may pass any reasoned order and the present impugned order may be set aside in this regard.

4. From a perusal of the impugned order (Annexure P-4), it is clear that the same is an unreasoned order by which the permission granted earlier was withdrawn.

5. In view of the above, all the present petitions are disposed of. Impugned orders vide Annexure P-4 in CWP No.9747-2019, Annexure P-4 in CWP-9752-2019, Annexure P-4 in CWP-9756-2019, Annexure P-4 in CWP-9758-2019, Annexure P-4 in CWP-9759-2019, Annexure P-3 in CWP-9761-2019 and Annexure P-4 in CWP-9762-2019, are hereby set aside. The Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ambala or any other competent authority, appointed in accordance with law is directed to pass a fresh order strictly in accordance with law within a period of two months from today after giving an opportunity of personal hearing to the affected persons.

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6. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) stated that by virtue of interim order passed by this Court in all the petitions, the petitioners are still working with the respondent and therefore, till the time the Assistant Registrar/any other competent authority passes any fresh order, they may be permitted to continue working.
7. The prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner(s) is not only justified but also not opposed by learned counsel for respondent(s). It is therefore directed that till the time fresh order is passed by the respondent-society/competent authority, the petitioner(s) shall be permitted to work on the post on which they are already working.
8. Disposed of.
9. Since the main cases have been disposed of, applications for impleadment, shall also stand disposed of.
