1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of minor children namely Priya & Diksha (daughters) and Daksh (Son) aged about 10 years, 4 years and 3 years respectively.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that as per instructions received by him, all the minor children of the petitioner are in her custody.
3. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today, despite the fact that the matter has been passed over twice. Even on the last date of hearing, none was present on her behalf.
4. Apparently, the petitioner does not seem interested to pursue this petition. Accordingly, the same stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
