1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an order, direction or a writ especially in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to issue appointment letter and to allow the petitioner to join on the post of Assistant Manager (Estate) being an eligible and selected candidates along with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that both the petitioners had applied for the post of Assistant Manager (Estate) in the respondent-Corporation and also cleared the written examination for the same and got selected for the aforesaid post, but the respondent-Corporation are not issuing joining letter to them. He further submitted that the petitioners had served a representation dated 22.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.4-Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula in this regard, but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He submitted that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case the

aforesaid representation dated 22.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) is considered and decided by respondent No.4 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 & 4.
5. Mr. Jagbir Malik, Advocate, who is present in Court, puts appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.2 & 3.
6. Learned Addl. A.G., Haryana submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, he has no objection in case a time bound direction is issued by this Court.
7. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula to consider and decide the representation dated 22.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) strictly in accordance with law within a period of three months from today.
