- [1]. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for the issuance of writ of Habeas Corpus for directing the official respondents to produce the release the detenue namely Baljeet Kaur, who is in illegal detention of respondent Nos.4 to 14.
