CWP-9767-2019

The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner

for seeking issuance of directions to respondents to restore/provide the tubewell electricity connection for agricultural purposes and a further prayer to decide the representation dated 06.03.2019 and 14.03.2019 submitted by the petitioner was also made.

The short grievance espoused by the petitioner is that despite the petitioner being ready and wiling to pay all statutory charges for release of the electricity connection and being in settled possession of the land, the electricity supply is not being released to the petitioner.

Counsel for respondent Power Corporations submits that they have no objection to release the electricity connection in accordance with law subject to the petitioner fulfilling all the requisite terms and conditions of the applicable sale circulars.

In view of the aforesaid statement, counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition at this stage. Needless to mention that in the event of the petitioner submitting an application for release of the electricity connection in accordance with the applicable Sale Circulars/regulations notified by the distribution licensee, the electricity supply shall be released in favour of the petitioner within the time as prescribed under the Act.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of.
