1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner competed for selection to the Group-D post as advertised by the respondent-Commission vide advertisement No.1/2023 and though, in the written examination, the petitioner has secured 76.31 marks whereas, cut off in the category in which the petitioner is competing i.e. BC-B category was 74.9 marks but still the petitioner has not been selected for the post in question, which action on the part of the respondent is arbitrary and illegal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 09.03.2024 (Annexure P/7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

5. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that in case representation dated 09.03.2024 (Annexure P/7) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
