Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to include the plot Nos.210, 211, 213, 214, 234, 235, 253, 286, 287, 326, 361, 368 in western side and plot No.40 of northern side and other wrongly excluded plots of Village Jubbal, Tehsil Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar in Lal Dora Free Scheme.

It has been contended by counsel for the petitioner that under the Lal Dora Free Scheme, necessary action for demarcation was carried out but the demarcation carried out was not appropriately done. He submits that the petitioners having been prejudiced approached the competent authorities for redressal of their grievances by making the fresh demarcation. It is submitted that despite repeated requests and representations filed, no action has been taken by the respondents-authorities.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. She, on instructions, has submitted that learned DDPO has already directed the BDPO for constituting the committee for redressal of the grievances of the villagers which would hear

the grievances of the petitioner and similarly situated residents. It is

submitted that if the petitioners file appropriate representation, the same would be considered in accordance with law expeditiously.

Heard. On hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh representation before the BDPO-respondent No.5 within ten days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order for the redressal of their grievances and in case such representation is filed then respondent No.5-BDPO is directed to decide the same by providing the opportunity of hearing to the petitioners within two months from the date of filing of the same.
