SMT. VARINDER KAUR AND ORS. VS. JAGSIR SINGH AND ORS

Mr. Nitin Mittal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the appellants and filed Vakalatnama on their behalf. The same is taken on record.

As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellants, (separately recorded today), a sum of Rs.5,40,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Forty Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Learned counsel for the appellants has given a statement before this Forum that one of the claimants-appellants, namely Surjit Kaur has since expired on 19.12.2018 and there are no other legal heirs except the remaining claimants-appellants in this case. The death certificate has been placed on record. Her name be deleted from the array of parties. The amended memo of parties is being filed. As per instructions from the clients, learned counsel for the appellant states that the enhanced amount would be paid to appellant No.2-Mandeep Kaur.

We dispose of this case with a direction to Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.5,40,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Forty Thousand only) in the name of appellant No.2-Mandeep Kaur with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 12.09.2024 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
