1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the order dated 06.09.2023 passed in CWP-19703-2023.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and has referred to order dated 28.03.2024 and has submitted that the respondent is not proceeding against the petitioner in the departmental enquiry. On another letter received from the Vigilance Department, only fact and finding enquiry has been instituted qua the petitioner. No punishment is to be imposed upon the petitioner on the basis of said fact finding enquiry unless the charge is proved in the departmental enquiry separately initiated against the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the matter.
