1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of mandamus upon the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.
2. On an advance notice, the learned State counsel has caused appearance and submits on instructions imparted to him by ASI Gurmel Singh that thorough enquiry was conducted with regard to the threat perception, if any, and during the enquiry both the petitioners have suffered statements to the effect that they do not have any threat perception, as raised through the instant petition.
3. Faced with the above said difficulty, the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement suffered by the learned State counsel, he does not want to press the instant petition.
4. **Dismissed** as not pressed.
