AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

On the last date of hearing following order was passed:-

“Mr. M.S. Longia, Advocate and Mr. Saarib Aggarwal, Advocate appeared of behalf of appellants and filed their Power of Attorney on behalf of appellant Nos. 1 and 3, and MOA on behalf of appellant Nos. 2, 4 and 5.

It was stated if an amount of Rs.7,00,000/- is paid to the appellants over and above the amount already awarded by the MACT, issue involved in this matter can be settled. The proposal sheet has been signed by the learned counsel for the appellants.

Learned counsel for the Insurance Company seeks an adjournment to get Instructions.

On his request, adjourned to 30.05.2024.

A copy of this order be supplied to the counsel for the Insurance company. ”

Mr. Saarib Aggarwal, Advocate for the appellants signed the consent proposal on 23.05.2024, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.7,00,000/-(Rupees Seven Lakhs Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal.

Mr. R.C. Kapoor, Advocate and representatives for respondent No.2- Insurance Company have also signed the said statement today, accepting the proposal made by the counsel for the appellants.

As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellants as per MACT award.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed cheques in the sum of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Only) in the respective names of all the appellants in the same proportion as awarded by MACT with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 29.07.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Pending applications, if any shall stand disposed of.
