RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 21.11.2022 passed in CWP-26308-2022.
2. Reply by way of short affidavit of Kamal Kishor Yadav, Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of School Education, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 21.11.2022 passed in CWP-26308-2022 has been complied with and speaking order dated 16.06.2023 (Annexure R-3) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
