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AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.5

The appeal stands settled at Rs.6,50,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal in terms of proposal form dated 06.02.2024 duly signed by both the parties.

Appellant No.2 who is present states that all the appellants are residing in the same house. In the settlement form, the appellant No.2 on behalf of all the appellants has signed the settlement with the request that the amount which has been determined to be paid over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal below be paid in the name of Smt. Sita Devi, appellant No.1, his mother.

Accordingly, this award is made with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs.6,50,000/- (Rupees Six Lacs and Fifty Thousand Only) by cheque/draft, in favour of appellant No.1-Sita Devi with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 30.03.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order.

It is further directed that on deposit of the cheque by the Insurance Company, the information to appellant No.2 shall be sent on the Mobile No.8558000021 who is now residing at VPO Khizrabad, District Mohali, Tehsil Kharar, so that the same is collected by the appellant from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the appellant.

Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
