By way of present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for his release on regular bail in a case arising out of FIR No.62 dated 22.08.2023, under Sections 304, 34 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

2. Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Talwinder Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Dhuri, District Sangrur alongwith custody certificate has been filed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only attribution to the petitioner is that had he alongwith co-accused Manpreet Singh taken the deceased to the hospital at appropriate time and provided medical help to him, he could have survived. Learned counsel contends that no specific attribution is made to the petitioner. Besides, co-accused, namely, Manpreet Singh has already been allowed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 29.01.2024 passed in CRM-M-3571-2024 (Annexure P-3).

4. Learned State counsel concedes the fact that the case of the petitioner is on parity with co-accused, Manpreet Singh, who has already been allowed bail vide Anenxure P-3.
5. Petitioner is in custody for the last 09 months and 05 days, as per the custody certificate with no other criminal case pending against him.
6. The trial is likely to take long time to conclude.
7. Considering all the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
