Main case

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted before this Court that cancellation report has been filed by the Investigating Agency in this case, however, the same has been filed without appreciating the facts and circumstances of the case. He has submitted that multiple enquiries had been conducted in this case. He has drawn the attention of this Court to the order



dated 09.05.2022, wherein it was observed that report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. would be subject to the outcome of the present case.

3. This is an admitted position that cancellation report has already been filed in this case and the same is pending adjudication before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate. In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the parties to raise their grievance before learned Illaqa Magistrate, where the cancellation report is pending, who after hearing both the sides would proceed with the cancellation report in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of two months from today.
