1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 01.05.2023 passed in CWP-1917-2019.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 01.05.2023 passed in CWP-1917-2019 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
