RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 01.05.2023 passed in CWP-7856-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Er. Satpal Singh Lal, Additional Superintending Engineer, PSPCL, O & M Division Mohali, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 01.05.2023 passed in CWP-7856-2023 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 22.04.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
