Amended petition has been filed in compliance of order dated 16.04.2024. A copy has been given to learned State counsel who has resisted the prayer of grant of interim bail by submitting that the offence alleged to be committed by the petitioner is heinous in nature and the fact that the marriage of the sister of the petitioner is to be performed on 23.04.2024 is, however, not controverted by the respondent-State. Keeping in view the submission as made in the petition, the order dated 27.03.2024 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Faridabad is ordered to be modified and it is directed that the petitioner shall be given benefit of interim bail till **30.04.2024** subject to his furnishing two sureties in the like amount of Rs.4 lakhs each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court and further subject to the condition that during the period of his release on interim bail, he will not contact the victim or his family members and will not intimidate the witnesses. He will surrender before concerned Jail authorities on **01.05.2024** before **05.00** PM.
