RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 07.05.2022 passed in CWP-15380-2021.
2. A perusal of the paper book shows that the order pertains to the transfer which was made in the year 2022. In the said transfer order, the petitioner was given a particular place of posting, which was never objected to by him. Now, after two years, once again the petitioner has raised the issue alleging that he was wrongly transferred two years back. However, this Court does not find that this argument could fit in the scope of the Contempt Court jurisdiction. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
3. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
