[1]. Present criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioners praying for protection to their life and liberty, in view of the marriage solemnized by them against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 09.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) moved at the instance of petitioners by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

3. Prayer seems to be justified.

4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Viranjeet Singh Mahal, Addl. PP UT, Chandigarh appears on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

5. In view of the aforesaid, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representation dated 09.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks’ from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
