watercourse as granted vide impugned orders. Learned counsel for respondent No. 4 affirms that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties and they do not require watercourse as granted by the orders under challenge.

3. Respondent No. 4-Roop Singh who is present in Court has suffered statement that he does not want any water khal and as such the present petition may be disposed of as per the compromise. He has further stated that he has no objection if the orders passed by Canal Authorities in his favour are set aside. His statement has been recorded separately.

4. In view of the compromise effected between the parties and the statement suffered by respondent No. 4, present petition is disposed of and the order dated 14.08.2019 (Annexure P-2) and order dated 04.03.2021 (Annexure P-3) under challenge in this petition are set aside.
