RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, read with Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.03.2023 passed in CWP-25489-2018.
2. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 22.03.2023 passed in CWP-25489-2018 has since been complied with and necessary order dated 04.06.2024 has been passed, whereby claim of the petitioner has been rejected. Copy of order dated 04.06.2024 has been produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
