AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Narender Mohan Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to take appropriate legal action on account of death of Lakhwinder Singh and to investigate the matter and take appropriate legal action on representation filed by petitioner dated 23.08.2019 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that Lakhwinder Singh was posted as Security Guard and he was working inside the godown where pesticides were used to preserve the grains. On 20.03.2019, Lakhwinder Singh was working in the godown and due to the toxic effect of pesticides

and chemicals, he fell unconscious and later on died. No appropriate legal action was taken by the police authorities. He filed representation dated 23.08.2019 (Annexure P-1). Ultimately, he filed present petition.

3. Status report has been received. As per status report, statement of Jaipal (father of deceased Lakhwinder Singh @ Lucky) has been recorded who stated that his son was doing private job of Security Guard in Kataar Security Group and was deputed in PUNSUP godown Tanda. He received call that health condition of his son was not good and to reach immediately. When he reached the godown, he noticed his son lying unconscious who was rushed to Civil Hospital Tanda and on the way to the hospital, he died of heart attack. Proceedings under Section 174 Cr.P.C. were conducted. DDR No.43 dated 20.03.2019 was recorded at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur. Statement of father of deceased victim Jaipal is Annexure R-1/T. Inquiry was conducted. Statements of relevant persons were recorded. Post-mortem was also conducted and report of Forensic Science Laboratory has been received, according to which no poison was detected in the contents of exhibits tested in the laboratory which is Annexure R-2. Thereafter, doctor has given his opinion that cause of death in this case is acute Myocardium infarction which was sufficient to cause death in ordinary course of nature. Station House Officer, Police Station Tanda recommended to file the application No.770-PD dated 23.03.2019 and the application has been filed by Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur.

4. I have considered the arguments. Present petitioner is maternal uncle of deceased Lakhwinder Singh. In view of the status report, learned counsel for petitioner stated that appropriate orders may be passed. As per

the opinion of doctor it is not the case of death by poisoning. In fact it was a case of acute Myocardium infarction which was sufficient to cause death in the ordinary course of nature. After due inquiry, representation given by petitioner has been filed.

6. In light of the status report, no further direction is required and the present petition is accordingly disposed of.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
