1. The present petition has been filed seeking exercise of all inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. *inter alia* praying for quashing of the FIR No.138 dated 09.07.2023, under Sections 323,452,506 and 34 of IPC (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. Keeping in view the fact that the parties entered into a compromise, this Court vide order dated 24.04.2024 directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate for getting their statements recorded in that regard. Pursuant thereto, a report dated 23.05.2024 has been received from the Sub Division Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, stating that statements of the

parties have been recorded. A perusal of the report demonstrates that only one of the accused namely Harwinder Singh has compromised the matter with the complainant.

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh as and when all the accused join hands or after the decision of the Division Bench on the reference as to whether partial compromise is permitted or not. It is made clear that despite the withdrawal of this petition, the complainant shall be bound down with the compromise.
