Custody certificate filed by the State counsel is taken on record.

This is second bail petition. The earlier bail petition bearing CRM-M-45501-2023 was dismissed as withdrawn by this Court vide order dated 20.12.2023 (Annexure P-5), which reads as under:

“Short reply by way of affidavit of Shri Sucha Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police. P.B.I-NDPS Cum Narcotics, Amritsar-Rural has been filed on behalf of the respondent- State, along with the custody certificate. After arguing the case for some time, statement is made by learned counsel for the petitioner so as to withdraw the present petition at this stage, with liberty to file fresh petition after recording statement of the complainant of the case, during trial. In view of the afore-said statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage, with the liberty afore-said ”

It is conceded by learned counsel for the petitioner that statement of the complainant has not been recorded till date.

In view of the above, the present petition is not maintainable, having regard to the condition on which the liberty to file the subsequent petition was granted.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
