1. In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the order dated 29.03.2019, copy of which has been appended with this petition as Annexure P-2 by which, the petitioner has been suspended from the service.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the reason given by the respondents for suspension is that there is an FIR No.13 dated 18.05.2018 pending against the petitioner wherein, the charges have been framed. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the trial in pursuance to the said FIR is about to conclude hence, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents for appropriate relief in case the petitioner is acquitted in the criminal proceedings.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received from the petitioner, the same will be disposed of in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of six weeks of the receipt of the same and in case the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
