HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for issuing him the Gradation Certificate as per the policy dated 25.05.2018.
2. In the reply, the respondents have mentioned that the petitioner is claiming the Gradation Certificate on the basis of sports “Wushu”, which game is not included in the policy itself, hence, no Gradation Certificate can be issued to the petitioner on the basis of the participation in the said sports.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the said game in which the petitioner has participated, has wrongly been excluded from the policy, the petitioner intends to challenge the policy itself hence, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the policy in question.
4. Ordered accordingly.
5. Any civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
