HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to transfer back the petitioner from Central Jail, Ludhiana to Central Jail, Bathinda, due to pending trial in the Court of learned Sessions Court, Bathinda.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 19.03.2024 (P-2) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

[3] The above prayer seems to be justified.

[4] Notice of motion.

[5] Mr. Athar Ahamd, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents-State and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner. He, on instructions from Mr. Kuldeep Singh Chahal, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, also assures the Court that the petitioner shall be produced before the trial Court

on the next date of hearing, which is stated to be fixed for 01.05.2024.

[6] In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this petition is **disposed off** with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider the aforesaid representation dated 19.03.2024 (P-2) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of six (06) weeks from today.

[7] The respondents-State shall be bound by its assurance as taken before this Court.
