1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted his representation (Annexure P-1) in this regard, however, the same has not been taken into consideration by the official respondents.
3. Upon advance notice, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab appears on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that on the contrary upon a representation submitted by respondent No.4, FIR already stands registered against the petitioner qua the allegations of having played fraud

with private respondent.

4. In view of the aforesaid, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is dismissed. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail his remedy in accordance with law.
