The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the order dated 09.10.2002 (Annexure P-16) passed by respondent No.1, vide which the order passed by respondent Nos.2 to 4 has been upheld and also orders dated 17.01.1992, 15.09.1992 and 30.08.2000 (Annexures P-8, P-10 and P-14) passed by respondents No.2, 3 and 4 respectively.
