1. On 20.03.2024, this Court passed the following order:-

“As per office report, notice issued to the counsel for the appellant, Mr. R.K. Joshi, Advocate has been received back with the report that he has died. His associate counsel Mr. Rajesh Joshi, Advocate was also informed vide Court letter No.3849 dated 14.03.2024, but the report received that he is not practicing.

In this case, the appellant-Gurdial Singh is being represented through attorneys i.e. his sons, namely, Avtar Singh and Darshan Singh. Registry has reported that the attorney Avtar Singh has refused to accept notice and hence, affixation made. Another attorney Darshan Singh is unserved as the house was found locked.

Let notice to Darshan Singh, attorney of appellant, be issued for 08.04.2024.

To be taken immediately after urgent cases.”

2. As per the office report dated 06.04.2024, though attorney Darshan Singh accepted summons but refused to affix his signatures whereas another attorney Avtar Singh refused to accept notice and hence, affixation made.

3. In view of above, it seems that the appellants are not interested in pursuing the present appeal. Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution.

4. Pending application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.

5. However, if the appellants want to revive this appeal, they are at liberty to move an application within one month from today.
