1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.172 dated 07.11.2023, under Sections 294, 341, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of IPC Act, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot and lateron added offence under Section 326 IPC vide DDR No.24 dated 13.11.2023 registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot and lateron deleted offence under Section 294 IPC vide DDR No.25 dated 30.01.2024, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot. Further prayer has been made that the arrest of the petitioner kindly be stayed.
2. Vide order dated 10.07.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 10.07.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.



4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmukh Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above, interim order dated 10.07.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands allowed.
