1. The present contempt proceedings have been initiated by the Court for non-compliance of order dated 20.01.2024 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.448 of 2024 because of the fact that the FSL authorities had not taken the documents from the State counsel and had not examined the same forensically despite Court orders.

2. Today, learned counsel for the respondents-State has submitted that the order has since been complied with. After getting possession of all the relevant documents, as ordered by the Court, and after forensically examining the same, the report qua the said documents has already been submitted before the Division Bench. The same has already been taken on record by the Division Bench, vide its order dated 22.04.2024 and the matter has been listed by the said Division Bench on 23.07.2024 for further proceedings.

3. Accordingly, it is further submitted that earlier the deficiency happened because of the administrative exigencies and there was no



intentional disobedience of the order of the Division Bench of this Court. In any case, the respondents submit their un-qualified apology for the said deficient conduct relating to non-compliance of the order.

3. Since the order has now been complied with and the respondents have tendered their unqualified apology, therefore, accepting the above said apology tendered by the respondents, the present petition is dismissed and proceedings are dropped.
