1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.0395 dated 11.12.2023, registered under Sections 147, 149, 307 and 506 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, at Police Station Dadri Sadar, District Charkhi Dadri.
