KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. the petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.0073 dated 18.2.2020, Under Sections 201/212/302/364/412/120-B/34 IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.
2. At the very outset, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by ASI Gautam Kumar, submits that out of total 22 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 21 witnesses have already been examined and only one prosecution witness remains to be examined and the next date for the examination of the last prosecution witness is fixed for 9.4.2024.
3. Considering the stage of the trial, which is at concluding stage and considering the fact that in the instant matter, the petitioner is facing trial under Section 302 IPC, that too, based upon the circumstantial evidence, this Court is not inclined to interfere at this stage.
4. Therefore, the instant petition is ordered to be **dismissed**.
