The petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.184 dated 23.06.2023 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC read with Section 82 of the Registration Act, 1908 registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 22.04.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 22.04.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.



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In view of the above, the interim order dated 22.04.2024 is made absolute.
