AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

The petitioner – Dalwinder Singh @ Dilvinder Singh @ Sunny has filed the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 88 dated 18.03.2024 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 427, 148 and 149 of IPC (Section 307 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar.

2. Brief facts of the case are that Amit complainant got his statement recorded that on 17.03.2024 he had gone to main bazaar Mubarakpur on motorcycle bearing Registration No. PB-70-D-5816 Splendor. He was standing near the temple when he was surrounded by Godhu Jangi, Bobby (sardar), Bobby (Nepalese type), Ashu, Sunyar, Sunny, Rohit, Mohit, Billa and Ghuggi who were armed with sword and crowbar. Godhu, Ashu, Bobby are attributed *Kirpan* blows on the person of complainant, whereas, others named Billa, Rohit, Mohit, Sunny and

Ghuggi along with other unknown persons are attributed blows while he was lying on the ground. He was rescued by Pawan Kumar and others.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that he was granted *interim* bail vide order dated 18.04.2024 and accordingly, he has joined the investigation. He is not attributed any specific blow. No recovery is to be effected from him. Other co-accused Mohit was granted regular bail by the Court of learned Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali vide order dated 10.04.2024, which is Annexure P-4. He is still ready to join the investigation. It is prayed that his anticipatory bail application may be allowed.

4. Learned counsel representing the State pointed out at the instance of ASI Surinder Singh, No. 63 SAS, Police Station Dera Bassi that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any other purpose.

Considering the aforesaid factual position that petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for any other purpose, the *interim* anticipatory bail already granted vide order dated 18.04.2024 stands confirmed, subject to the conditions detailed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition is accordingly allowed.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
