Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.30 dated 17.02.2024, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC added later on at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar.

Status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Vijay Kumar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar (additional charge) has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, in the Court today, same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Vide order dated 19.04.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 19.04.2024, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.



Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kamaljit, affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 19.04.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
