This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned notices dated 15.05.2023 (Annexure P-8) and 06.06.2023 (Annexure P-9) vide which the petitioner has been shown to be absent from the scrutiny process.
