1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C with a prayer to quash the FIR No. 94 dated 27.03.2024 under Sections 20 (b) (ii)(B) of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sector-40, Gurugram and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
2. After arguing at length, when this Court was not inclined to allow this petition, the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to raise all the pleas available to him, before the Trial Court at an appropriate stage.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.
4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the petitioner is a young boy and is a student; appropriate direction may be issued to the police to complete the investigation in some stipulated time period.

5. At this stage, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sandeep Singh submits that in the present case, the investigation is almost complete and final report of the investigation shall be presented before the competent Court within a period of six weeks from today.
