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Present application has been filed for disposal of the writ
petition.

Mr. Charan Preet Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab,
who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He
raises no objection for the grant of prayer as raised in the present
application.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which
are duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed.



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Keeping in view the agreement between the parties and the joint prayer, the main writ petition is taken up for hearing today itself.

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1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that the respondents should be restrained from obtaining Self declaration/ Undertaking from the petitioners before offering them appointment to the post of Master in the Master Cadre in pursuance to the recruitment notice dated 20.11.2015 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and grant the petitioners the appointment in accordance with law as given to the other batch-mates of the petitioners who competed in pursuance to the recruitment notice dated 20.11.2015.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present writ petition was admitted on the first date of hearing on 19.04.2023. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the claim of the similarly situated employees has been decided by the respondents and the respondents be directed that petitioners' claim be also decided in terms of the order dated 31.08.2020 (Annexure P-14) by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in case any such grievance is raised by the petitioners before the authorities concerned by filing any representation, the said representation will be decided in accordance with law keeping in view the grievance raised therein and appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any



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such claim and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief, the same will be granted to the petitioners otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representation with the respondents.

5. Ordered accordingly.
