AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

Two appeals, one bearing FAO-4597-2004 was filed by the widow and two minor children of the deceased and the other FAO-2664-2004 was filed by the parents of the deceased. The matter has been amicably settled after discussion. The Insurance company is ready to make payment of an amount of Rs.8,10,000/- over and above the amount allowed by MACT. It is also brought to our notice that after the death of Bhim Singh, his widow namely Mrs. Kavita had re-married and is living separate from the parents of the deceased. It is also stated that Ram Parsad father of the deceased had died and accordingly, the mother of the deceased namely Bhagwati Devi is entitled to the settled amount. It is also agreed between the counsel for the parties that 50% of the amount awarded be paid to the mother of the deceased namely Bhagwati Devi (in FAO-2664-2004) and the remaining 50% amount be paid to appellants No.1 to 3 (in FAO-4597-2004) in

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equal shares.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit four cheques, one for Rs.4,05,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Five Thousand only) favouring appellant No.2-Bhagwati Devi W/o Ram Parsad (in FAO-2664-2004), other three for Rs.1,35,000/-(Rupees One Lakh Thirty Five Thousand Only) each, favouring appellants No.1 to 3 (in FAO-4597-2004), with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 06.07.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeals stand disposed of.

Pending applications, if any shall stand disposed of.
