The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.83, dated 04.08.2015, under Sections 420, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka and others consequential proceedings arising therefrom against the petitioners.

Short reply dated 11.03.2019 by way of an affidavit of Manjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Abohar, District Fazilka has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State, which is taken on record.

A perusal of para No.3 of the said reply would depict that a cancellation report was prepared and presented to the Court of JMIC, Abohar on 22.04.2018 though the complainant did not agree with the said cancellation report and accordingly, re-investigation was ordered on 22.04.2018 itself. During the re-investigation as well, again the FIR was found to be false.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Resham Singh, submits that the cancellation report has been prepared but the same is yet to be presented to Court.

He undertakes that the cancellation report so prepared will be presented to the Competent Court within a period of three weeks from today after seeking necessary approval from the competent authorities.

In view of the undertaking given by learned State counsel, nothing survives in the instant petition and the same has been rendered infructuous and is disposed off as such.
