KARAMJIT SINGH, J.(Oral)

Counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners who are major are present in Court; that the petitioners got married on 12.4.2024 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7 who are extending threats to the petitioners and in this regard, representation Annexure P-5 is given to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action in this matter.

2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Yashwant Singh Rathore, Addl. PP UT, Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of State of U.T., Chandigarh and on instructions from HC Deepak submits that today itself, petitioner No.1 made statement before the concerned police official that she is living with her parents and is not apprehending any threat from them or any other private persons.
4. Faced with this situation, both the petitioners made statement that they are living together as husband and wife and are apprehending threat from the side of private respondents. On this, counsel for U.T.,

Chandigarh submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

5. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh to consider representation (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

6. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
