MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

2. At the outset, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gulzar Singh, has submitted that there is no threat perception qua the petitioners. In fact the petitioners are related to one Gaurav, who is facing trial in a case registered under Section 307 of the IPC. Learned State counsel, however, submits that in case in future any such threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners comes to the light of the official respondents, they would be duty bound to come to their rescue and take appropriate steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

3. In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel,

learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that he would not press the instant petition at this stage.

4. Dismissed as not pressed.
